GIA

In 2019, The State awarded WUC a Grant In Aid to be used towards the predevelopment cost of our Affordable Housing Project. We have been able to extend its expenditure as there have been so many concerns that we have had wait for approvals from the historic district etc. Our final deadline was in February and we were able to expend what we could from the grant. We were able to pay for architectural design work, our attorneys fees, and constant word by Hoku'lwa to keep the project moving forward working with a variety of entities.



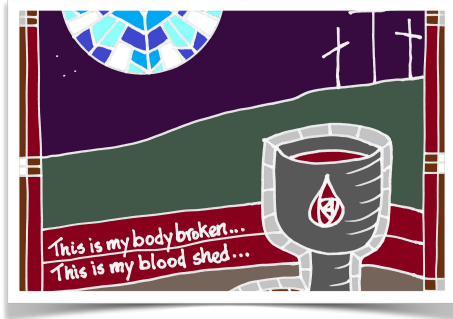
Mission Ground

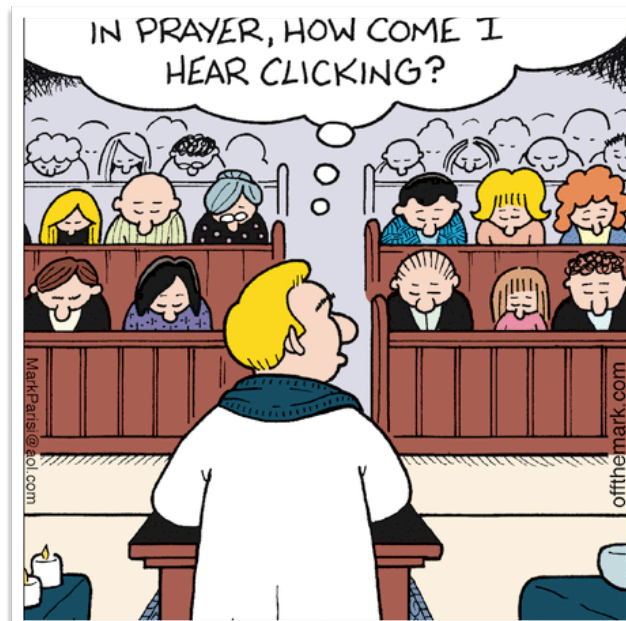
